

June to August 2015 rainfall forecast




Regional drought potential advisory

Based on rainfall anomaly classification over the past six months and forecast rainfall anomaly classification over the next 3 months

Fiji: Below to well below normal rainfall from March to May with below normal rainfall forecast from June to August.

Niue, Tonga: Below to well below normal rainfall experienced during April and May with normal or below normal rainfall forecast for Niue and below normal rainfall forecast for Tonga over the coming 3 months.

Society Islands, Tuamotu/Gambier Islands: Normal to well below normal rainfall experienced during April and May with normal or below normal rainfall forecast over the coming 3 months.
