
## Why play a game?

To deliver information in a way that activates









- People simply don't grasp the implications of the trade-offs and choices available or
- They have difficulty knowing how to combine information in a way that supports decision making.

## Game play allows the player to:

- Visualise options & multiple futures
- Experiment within a 'safe' environment
- Demonstrates a framework
- Learning from & with others
- Reveals values
- Builds relationships
- Games 'prime' further conversations

## Players gain:

- the confidence to start the planning and strategy process
- a framework to process complexity within their own context
- an understanding of science-based options and their limits
- an understanding of their values and the values of those around them
